Mr. Catania announced the start of the bid opening for the 2011 Ford F-350 Utility Truck and the Auburn Village Window Replacement.

Mr. Catania began with the 2011 Ford F-350 Utility Truck and the first bid which was from Fred Beans Lincoln Mercury from West Chester, PA with a bid bond in the amount of \$ 300.00. The total bid is in the amount of \$ 37,028.00.

The second bid from Hondru Ford from Manheim, PA with a bid bond in the amount of \$ 300.00. The total amount of the bid is \$ 41,601.00 with a Western Plow and with a Fisher Plow in the amount of \$ 42,817.00.

The third bid from Brian Hoskins Ford from Coatesville, PA with a bid bond for 10% of the bid. The total amount of the bid is \$ 35,100.00.

The fourth bid from Murphy Ford from Chester, PA with a bid bond in the amount of \$ 300.00. The total amount of the bid is \$ 36,237.50.

The final bid is from Winner Ford from Cherry Hill, NJ with a bid bond in the amount of \$ 300.00. The total amount of the bid is \$ 36,847.00.

The second set of bids for the Auburn Village Window Replacement Program began with a bid from Ellis Construction from Glen Mills with a bid bond for 10% of the bid in the amount of \$ 167,610.00.

The second bid is from Emerald Windows from Phila., PA with a bid bond for 10% of the bid. The total amount of the bid is \$ 167,157.00.

The third bid is from Garozzo & Scimeca Construction from Williamstown, NJ with a bid bond for 10% of the bid. The total amount of the bid is \$ 193,898.00.

The final bid is from Interstate Building Materials from Pittston, PA with a bid bond in the amount for 10% of the bid. The total amount of the bid is \$ 139,311.51.

Mr. Catania thanked everyone who participated, and stated the bids will be referred to Council to be reviewed at the Council meeting to be held on June 7, 2010.
