To Whom It May Concern:

Due to the effects of a major damaging wind and torrential rain storm that caused extensive damage to public and personal property, effective 7:30pm on Tuesday June 23, 2015, under the Authority granted to the Mayor under the Pennsylvania State Borough Code, I am declaring a state of emergency.

This State of Emergency is to allow for additional resources to insure the safety of our residents and the proper clean up of the Borough in the wake of such a devastating storm.

Unfortunately, due to a complete lack of means of communication in the Borough due to downed power, phone and cable lines, the original State of Emergency was communicated by the means of mobile communication. The Original State of Emergency declared on June 23, 2015 was extended on June 24, 2015 to run concurrent with the County State of Emergency declared that day by Chairman Mario Civera due to the continued lack of electricity in the Borough so that we could better police our streets and continue to clear the debris and damage caused by the storm.
